As he started to further enhance and perfect the system, he soon found himself helping other businesses solve their payment needs thru his services. Soon, he was servicing more clients in the payment business than in his TV production deals!

So, being a good businessperson, he decided to pivot, and dive into Fintech and founded PMI Americas.

Today, PMI Americas helps several European and US-based companies, by consulting and providing payment solutions to thousands of people throughout Latin America and the world.
